

RESOLUTION #11-03

Resolution for Fire Personnel Wages

Whitewater Township
Grand Traverse County

Whereas, Whitewater Township (Battalion #3) is a member of the Grand Traverse Fire Department-Rural Division, and

Whereas, the Grand Traverse Rural Fire Department Board adopted a Compensation Policy & Procedure at its regular meeting held on May 18, 2005, and

Whereas, the Grand Traverse Rural Fire Department Board at its regular meeting held on June 15, 2005, made a motion that the compensation be paid to the Township for firefighters currently being paid by their Township,

Be It Further Resolved, that the wage for responses to emergency incidents paid per run fire volunteers will be as follows effective April 1, 2011, with payment to be issued bi-weekly.

1. A member of Battalion # 3 of the Grand Traverse Rural Fire Department, who has met Rural's minimum fire fighter certification requirements, shall be paid \$22.00 per emergency response and \$11.00 per hour after the first two (two) hours worked.
2. A Battalion # 3 member who is a trainee, currently working toward minimum certification as documented to the township board, shall be paid \$11.00 per emergency response or the minimum hourly wage, whichever of the two is greater, and
3. Training, vehicle/equipment testing & maintenance, required meetings, public education/service shall be paid at an hourly rate of \$11.00 per hour.
4. A Battalion #3 member who is a trainee, currently working toward minimum certification as documented to the township board, shall be paid the minimum hourly wage for training, vehicle/equipment testing & maintenance, required meeting and public education/service.

A motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution was made by Hubbell and seconded by Boyd.
