On voice vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Welcome Gary Buczkowski. Gary indicates that he spent 40 years in a professional career in local Parks and Rec, park planning, registered landscape architect.

Unfinished Business:

1. Lossie Road Nature Trail (LRNT) wetland/bridge improvement. Purchase Order and communication have been made to Gosling Czubak to get started on the engineering plan.

Melton did a brief run through of the history of the project for Andrew Butler and Buczkowski.

Future ideas would be to add benches, signs, education signs, change the parking lot, plus.

Discussion of non-motorized vehicles, resident requests, easements and survey stakes.

Hubbell will get the survey quote on the east side and the property owner line.

- 2. Grand Traverse ARPA agreement: Re-vote December 12 approved.
- 3. BCNA trail design, the loop: Melton did a brief run through of the history of the project.

Discussion of easement rights, neighboring property owner and survey estimate to create a loop that would benefit the public and work for the property owner.

Can also just make the loop tighter and completely miss the property owner. Need board approval for about \$2000 to get an estimate, tentative plan from Lagerquist of the GT Regional Land Conservancy to make it more natural and lower maintenance. We have not gotten approval from the board.

Discussion of the BCNA trail to the water.

4. WWT park playground toddler equipment addition. Board voted yes to contract with Gosling Czubak for \$1740 to produce plan drawings. Working to get a PO issued to get this work scheduled. Township insurance company offers grants for playground landing zone upgrades.

Andrew notes that the park playground wouldn't even pass inspection with the weeds growing. Discussion of spraying or digging it up and pulling the roots.

Buczkowski notes to plan the engineering to add more equipment, pieces, etc.

Andrew will get another bucket swing for the swing set.

Item to be added to Agenda of 1/23/2024 PRAC meeting:

Answer to question by PRAC member on 11/21/2023 meeting as to whether malfeasance had been committed by board member.

In the PRAC meeting minutes of 11/21/2023 there were statements recorded by a member questioning whether a township board member had committed malfeasance.

After reviewing the 12/19/2023 PRAC meeting minutes, there is no record of that question being answered by the full committee. Malfeasance is a serious offense. The PRAC needs to answer the question asked in the public meeting 11/21/2023 as recorded.

Actionable item: Consider the legal definition of malfeasance and what prompted the committee member to imply that in a question.

Review what the PRAC thinks the township board liaison duties are.

List them and then compare them to the actual duties of a board liaison and add them to the PRAC bylaws so this is understood by all committee members.

Your disappointment in the voting of the township board on 11/14/23 To return the GT County ARPA fund grant money of \$95,000+ is understandable. Review what the duties of the township board liaison to your committee are. Is it a requirement that the board liaison to the PRAC vote yes at the board level for everything PRAC approves? The minutes of the 11/21/2023 meeting can never be changed now. There is only one opportunity to make corrections to the minutes of a meeting and that is at the next meeting before they are approved. Each PRAC member approved the 11/21/2023 meeting minutes at your 12/19/2023 meeting. You now have a forever, permanent public record on the township website of these statements.

Michigan Township Association Authorities and Responsibilities of Michigan Townships 2020 Edition, page 164.

MCL 15.269 states that "The public body shall make any corrections in the minutes at the next meeting after the meeting to which the minutes refer."

The modification of your statements can now only be changed by an agenda item and answer the question asked in the 11/21/23 meeting by the PRAC member. Was malfeasance committed? See definition. If a vote of no, an apology would take less than 1 minute of the committee's time to correct a mistake if that is how the vote goes.

Legal definition of malfeasance:

malfeasance

n. intentionally doing something either legally or morally wrong which one had no right to do. It always involves dishonesty, illegality, or knowingly exceeding authority for improper reasons.

PRAC after action report:

When was first knowledge of the contract known by PRAC members? Grant awarded 12/22/22

When was grant contract sent to township board by PRAC for approval for first time? GT County ARPA coordinator last exchanged emails with Clerk Goss on July 10, 2023. Later Clerk Goss received the email reminder on October 12, 2023 from GT County ARPA grant coordinator as there had been no signed contract submitted. What action was taken by PRAC between 7/10/2023 and 10/12/23 to put the grant contract on the

township board agenda for their approval and signature?


When did PRAC have discussions with any township board member and board liaison Don Glenn about the contract before 11/14/23 board meeting requesting approval of the grant contract?
