Whitewater Township Batting Cage Use Rules & How to Reserve Use

- 1. All usage of the batting cage must be scheduled through the Township Clerk's office, phone 231-267-5141 x24, <u>clerk@whitewatertownship.org</u>, or the office is located at 5777 Vinton Road, Williamsburg, MI. The application form may be obtained at the Clerk's office or at <u>www.whitewatertownship.org</u> under the Information section on the home page.
- 2. Usage is limited to the date and time noted on the application. Other individuals or groups may have reserved the batting cage earlier or later in the day.
- 3. All persons must wear helmets at all times while in the cage.
- 4. Only one batter is allowed in the cage at any time.
- 5. Closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times.
- 6. All individuals outside of the batting cage must remain 3'-0" back from suspended netting at all times.
- 7. No hitting balls against facility walls.
- 8. Protective netting shall never be pulled back in any way.
- 9. Users must assure that all balls and pitching equipment are picked up and placed in their proper containers in the shed at the end of utilization.
- 10. Leave the cage, shed, and surrounding area clean for the next user.
- 11. All shed doors must be locked when done. Reset the exterior lock code to 0000.
- 12. Whitewater Township is not responsible for any injuries incurred while using this facility.
- 13. Batting cage equipment is not sanitized between users.
- 14. Whitewater Township reserves the right to refuse use to anyone not abiding by these rules.
