New Business (7:30 p.m.)**MICHIGAN PARTICIPATING PLAN – INSURANCE**

Motion to renew the insurance policy offered by Municipal Underwriters of West Michigan through the Michigan Township Participating Plan at an annual rate of \$33,717 as quoted April 29, 2022, by Vollmuth, second by Glenn.

Discussion followed regarding coverages.

Vollmuth will inform the insurance company to reevaluate when the dugouts are complete.

TOBIN & CO. – AUDIT ENGAGEMENT LETTER

Motion to approve the expenditure of up to \$7000 for the FYE 03/31/2022 audit and F-65 preparation, and to authorize the clerk to sign the engagement letter dated 04/26/2022, by Popp, second by Glenn.

Discussion followed.

Popp withdrew the motion, Glenn withdrew the second.

Motion that New Business item No.2, Tobin & Co. Audit Engagement Letter, be tabled until the July 12, 2022, meeting to potentially review alternative services, by Glenn, second by Vollmuth.

REVIEW/MODIFY/APPROVE ARPA SURVEY

Motion to accept the ARPA survey questions as modified by the Whitewater Township Board at its June 15, 2022, meeting and to provide printed copies to the Treasurer to be included in the summer tax envelopes, by Popp, second by Vollmuth.

Discussion followed and verbiage changes made. Popp will print, and volunteers from the audience will fold and present to the Treasurer.

HI PRAY PARK – PROPOSED CLOSURE OF PLAYGROUND DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS

Motion instructing the Park and Recreation Administrator to close the playground area to public use at the Hi Pray Park due to ongoing equipment safety deficiencies and install signage to that effect, by Popp, second by Glenn.

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Popp recognized that PRAC Chair, Melton, is available in the audience.

Discussion followed.

Popp suggested to reconstruct/enhance the park using leftover recreation funds from the storm cleanup and possibly add more funds from the General Fund.

Melton explained the 2019 playground inspection reports and discussed guidelines vs. mandates. PRAC requested funding to address the issues and was denied via the 2022/2023 budget. Melton's understanding is that moving the borders is all that needs to be done to meet the guidelines.

Popp would like to bring on an engineer for the playground update at the park.

We can get another inspection soon.

Popp amended the motion instructing the Park and Recreation Administrator to close the playground area to public use at the Hi Pray Park due to ongoing renovation and install signage to that effect, amended motion second by Glenn.

Followup discussion ensued regarding implementation and engineer options. Popp will reach out to Fleis & VandenBrink and C2AE and bring back design costs to the July meeting.

Melton is requesting a pause on the closure of the playground. Bring in an inspector and take it from there.

Popp indicates that he has no problem spending monies to make the park ADA compliant.

Roll call: Glenn-yes; Popp-yes; Benak-n/a; Goss-n/a; Vollmuth-yes. Motion carried.

PARK RANGER WAGES

Motion to approve 2022 wages for Alexandria DeVol, Jacob Olds, and David Wagner, as recommended by the Clerk, by Vollmuth, second by Popp.

TOWNSHIP BOARD RECORDING SECRETARY

Motion to discuss who will record the minutes and how will it be paid for, by Popp, second by Vollmuth.

Popp notes there is subcontracting allowed, like the assessor position. Discussed possible resolution, budget amendment, conflict of office, contract services and budgetary concerns.

Popp will present the question to legal: What allows any township elected official to contract out statutory duties?

Popp withdrew the motion; Vollmuth withdrew the second.

Popp will send the question to legal, to include the supervisor's office also.

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Motion to add Addendum No. 1 to Lawn-N-Order Independent Contractor Agreement and to authorize the clerk to sign on behalf of Whitewater Township by Vollmuth, second by Glenn.

Discussion followed.

Roll call: Vollmuth-yes; Goss-n/a; Glenn-yes; Benak-n/a; Popp-yes. Motion carried.
