The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) invites the public to an open house to discuss the upcoming M-72 reconstruction project that will occur from the Kalkaska/Grand Traverse County Line at Baggs Road east to the Village of Kalkaska at Kalkaska Road. The meeting will follow an open house format where the plans will be available for review with opportunities for residents, commuters, and businesses to ask questions.

**General information:**

Starting on April 16<sup>th</sup> there will be a single lane of traffic operating with flaggers. During the period from June 23<sup>rd</sup> to September 3<sup>rd</sup>, two lanes of traffic open at all times. After September 3<sup>rd</sup>, the operations will go back to flagging traffic as needed to complete the project. Expect some delay and backups.
