Resolution to Establish a Receiving Board for Elections

Whitewater Township
Grand Traverse County

Whereas, Michigan Election Law provides in MCL 168.679a that the legislative body of a city, township or village may, by resolution, provide that one or more additional boards of election inspectors be appointed to serve as a Receiving Board of election inspectors at an election at which the ballots are counted and certified at the precinct; and

Whereas, not less than two election inspectors in a precinct, representing each of the major political parties, shall deliver to the Receiving Board for that precinct in a sealed transfer case, the poll book and statement of votes; and

Whereas, the Receiving Board shall open the sealed transfer case and review the statement of returns to determine that the number of individuals voting recorded in the poll book equals the number of ballots issued to electors, as shown by the statement of votes; and

Whereas, the Election Commission shall appoint a Receiving Board consisting of not less than two election inspectors, with an equal number of election inspectors from each major political party; and

Whereas, the Township Clerk, as chair of the Election Commission of the Township of Whitewater recommends that a Receiving Board be established for all future elections, beginning with November 2012;

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Whitewater Township Board of Trustees authorizes a Receiving Board for all future elections beginning with the November 2012 General Election.

A motion to adopt the foregoing resolution was made by Hubbell and seconded by Boyd.


