Township

WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intent has been requested by The Tribe from the Whitewater Township Board in order to continue the development of a potential Intergovernmental Agreement between The Tribe and Whitewater Township for a future Emergency Services Facility; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intent will allow for further investigation to determine the size of facility needed to house all of Whitewater Township's Fire and Ambulance equipment; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intent will allow for further investigation to determine the operational costs of a new Emergency Services Facility; and

WHEREAS, if the proposed facility and operational costs are satisfactory to the Whitewater Township Board, a Resolution of Intent will allow for an Intergovernmental Agreement to be drafted stating the obligations of both Whitewater Township and The Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Whitewater Township Board agrees that further investigation into an Emergency Services Facility can be conducted.
