

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOWNSHIP HALL TO FOOT TRAFFIC

Effective 03/24/2020

On 03/24/2020, due to the coronavirus situation, the Whitewater Township Board voted to close the township hall to foot traffic through the duration of Executive Order 2020-21 and any extensions of the order. The executive order took effect on March 24, 2020, at 12:01 a.m. and continues through April 13, 2020, at 11:59 p.m.

However, various departments continue to be available to serve Whitewater Township residents and taxpayers via phone, email, or advance appointment.
